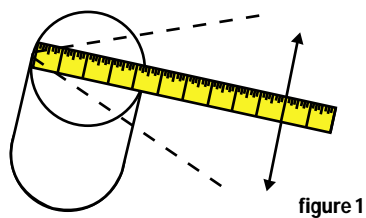


Three critical dimensions needed before ordering your deep or shallow well hand pump

- Q How high is your well casing above ground
- Q Inside and Outside diameter of your well casing--follow figure 1 to measure the i.d. of your well casing. Roll the tape measure back and forth to read the largest diameter. Measure the outside diameter also.
- Q Static water level--the static water level is the distance from the ground to the top of the water in your well. Typically set the pump cylinder 20 feet below static level.

How deep will a Bison Pump lift water from?

Our deep well Bison Pump will lift water from a water level of 300 feet.

How deep will a shallow well pump lift water?

The maximum depth any shallow well pump will lift is approximately 28 feet.

How do I connect the well head to my existing well?
